Our mission is the protection and preservation of rocky shore intertidal life, nesting and migrating sea birds, and marine mammals that inhabit Devil's Punch Bowl State Natural Area, Otter Rock Marine Gardens, Otter Rock Marine Reserve, and the Oregon Islands National Wildlife Refuge.

As a volunteer, you will interact with visitors at the Devil's Punchbowl State Natural Area, inspiring stewardship and raising awareness of Otter Rock Marine Reserve. Through several training opportunities, we will teach you about our local wildlife, geology, and history, and equip you with interpretive techniques to connect with visitors.



This program will run from late-May through early September. Volunteers should aim to commit to at least one 2-hour time slot each week. Time slots range between 9am - 5pm throughout the week, with a focus on weekend coverage.
